Copays:

Many hospitals will work with patients and families that are willing to pay their bill with or without insurance and most will offer payment plans or even discounts on your bills. Medicare Donut Hole:

1. The term Donut Hole describes a gap in coverage for prescription drugs.
2. A person pays a specified amount for their prescription drugs, and once they meet this deductible, their plan takes over the funding.
3. However, when the plan has paid up to a specified limit, the person has reached the donut hole.
4. Once they reach this point, a person has to start paying for their medications again until they reach another specified amount. After this, their plan takes over payment once again.
5. Always talk with your provider if you fall into this donut hole, the provider may be able to help you.
